Summary

This Bermuda Merchant Shipping Information Notice is issued to provide guidance on Port State Control Concentrated Inspection Campaigns (CIC).

This Notice was issued on 19th May 2022.

1. Summary

(1) Periodically Port State Control MOU's conduct Concentrated Inspection Campaigns to target a specific aspect of shipboard operations on ships calling into their jurisdictions to raise both the standard of the chosen aspect as well as industry awareness.

(2) BSMA know of the following CIC's that are currently in force:

- a. Australia Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) 1st May 2022 – 30th June 2022
Hours of Work and Rest

The purpose of this CIC is to assess:

- i. The level of compliance with the maximum hours of work or minimum hours of rest for seafarers in accordance with the requirements of International Conventions, and
- ii. The familiarity of the master and officers with implementing the provisions when working onboard ships.

(3) The above campaigns will target compliance on all vessels, regardless of type, in conjunction with the regular Port State Control inspection.
